Highlights

1) Health and Nutrition Program:

- Delivering the Medication and medical supplies to the targeted health facilities in Khanfir District, Abyan Governorate.

5) FSL Program:

- YDN have continue the food security project in four governorates Taiz, Marib, Abyan, and Shabwa where YDN have distributed the third cycle for 15607 HH in order to providing food security needs for vulnerable IDPs funded by KS relief.
- YDN provided emergency food baskets assistant distributions for one round in April and May months to a number of districts in Abyan, Taiz, Shabwa, Aden governorates.

6) Protection Program:

- Providing orphans with insurance cards and cash transfer support in Marib governorate.








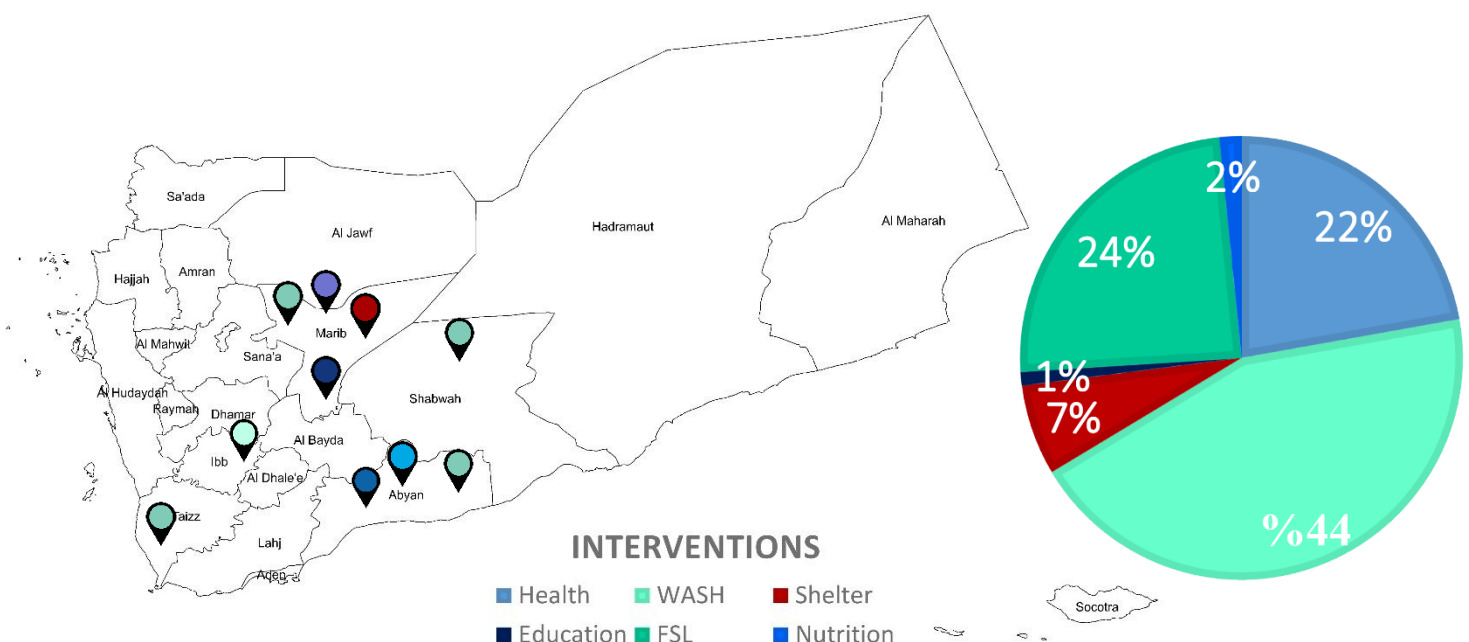

Health and Nutrition Program

Delivering the Medication and medical supplies to the targeted health facilities in Khanfir District, Abyan Governorate:

On 9th of April, the targeted health facilities were delivered with the first batch of medications and supplies, the project's team visited the targeted health facilities and oriented the health on the project services and activities.

Those medications were distributed according to a distribution plan to cover the needs and to start provision of the services to the beneficiaries.

Providing and delivering medical equipment and furniture to the targeted health facilities in Khanfir District, Abyan Governorate :

On 24th of May, the health facilities were provided with equipment and instrument including, trollies, vaccine carries, midwife kits, oxygen cylinders, sets, refrigerator, thermometers, and others.

Conducting Field visits to the targeted HFs in Khanfir District, Abyan Governorate :

Regular field visits were conducted to the targeted health facilities by the field teams. Through the visits assessing the progress of the services provided, discuss the needs of the health facilities and health workers, and ensure that the services are provided according to national standards and assess the satisfaction of the beneficiaries. In addition, complaint boxes have been installed, accountability hearings have been held and posters hanged in walls. Also, to ensure the quality of the work, the records were reviewed, shortcomings were recorded and the complaints and feedback mechanism were explained.

Providing Nutrition services in the targeted health facilities in Abyan governorate:

The project is targeting one rural hospital, two health units, and a medical mobile team with nutrition services including treatment of sever acute malnutrition (SAM) and moderate acute malnutrition (MAM) cases for children aged 6 – 59 month, screening of acute malnutrition for children and PLWs, treatment of PLWs with MAM, IYCF awareness, and prevision of Micro-nutrient powder (MNP) and wash kits for SAM cases.

Selection of CHVs to deliver Community Based Health and Nutrition Service:

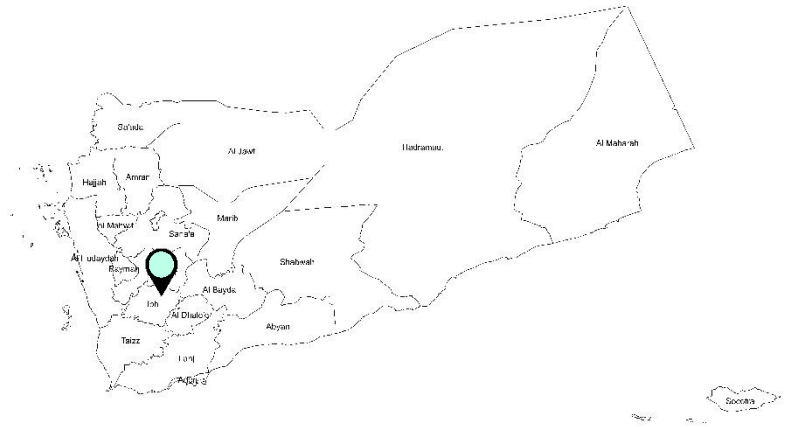
On 4th of Jane 2022, the selection of CHNVs started targeting all HFs in the district, the implementation was done in coordination and cooperation of the DHO and GHO , and the selection was done

successfully and within the target for CHNVs, four HFs in the district were targeted. The criteria of selections were described to the community and all CHNVs were selected according to this approved and endorsed criteria by MoPHP, it was ensured that the selected CHNVs are from and live in the same district to ensure effectiveness and sustainability of the services provided to the targeted community.

Shelter Program

Distributing the cash assistance the fourth rounds:

Recipients of cash assistance were determined through the Verification Assessment Framework (VAF), which identifies the poorest and most vulnerable families based on Shelter Cluster criteria for selecting the beneficiaries. Cash assistance is meeting most beneficiaries' basic needs by helping them afford rent and pay monthly bills. It is also improving their lives by having a positive impact on beneficiaries' psychological well-being, food security, health, and educational access, through financial stability. YDN distributed the first round of rental subsidies in Marib City district, Marib Gov on the 20th of April 2022. Assistance was provided as a Cash grant for destitute or highly vulnerable persons or families that are otherwise at risk of imminent eviction or for persons who are at heightened protection risks such as unaccompanied minors, lonely females, and GBV survivors or persons susceptible to such harm.

Distributing NFIs for 300 Households in two IDPs Hosting Sites:

Regarding the project "Priority 1 and 3: Shelter Assistance to Vulnerable Conflict-Affected Households", YDN distributed

300 Essential Kit and 360 Bedding Kit for 300 HHs in two camps as the following:

- Marib district: Aal Fujayh, Alhazm. With 92 HHs. -Marib City district: Al-Ashraf, Ali Abdulmoghni 208 HHs. YDN supervised the entire distribution process to ensure beneficiaries received their items appropriately.

YDN extracted transportation and distribution permits and determined two points for the distribution through the local authorities. YDN provided basic training to the distribution team to ensure the distribution will be done perfectly.

Establish and implement a complaint and feedback mechanism:

For distributing the NFIs to the targeted beneficiaries, the accountability officer in YDN hold awareness sessions with the team of YDN and the beneficiaries of NFIs that illustrated the accountability and project activities also the complaints and suggestions management system, and the complaint receiving Channels. Also the of provision of cash for rental subsidies, the accountability officer in (YDN) carried out field visits to the national foundation for exchange and meeting the staff and the Vulnerable Conflict-Affected Households. Banners were posted in the exchange center (YDN) and donor (YHF) and also posters were posted in walls of exchange center that clarifying the complaints and suggestions management system, and the complaint receiving Channels.

Conduct PDM for the rental subsidies:

The PDM included household interviews and key informants interviews (KIIs) with a sample of the beneficiaries and community leaders. The questionnaires were designed, tested, and approved by

the YDN MEAL team. The data was collected in papers then reflected in Kobo Collect and analyzed in MS Excel.

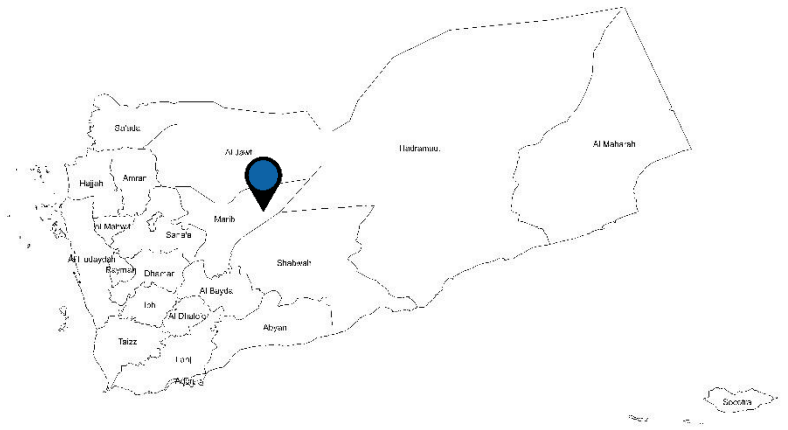
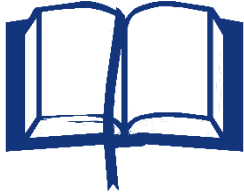

Education Program

Conducted orientation workshop for Education project team:

YDN conducted the orientation workshop for the education project in Marib district, Marib Gov. The orientation workshop aimed to increase the awareness of the staff and raise their level of understanding of all the responsibilities required of them during the project duration and to ensure the perfect implementation of the humanitarian projects, the project staff got enough knowledge about the project activities, performance indicators, means of verification and the project's workplan, etc. Therefore, an orientation workshop had been conducted by YDN for the project team.

In addition, the orientation workshop presented some aspects in child protection, case management and referrals. Education in emergencies, Accountability for affected people and presented the project plan for the project team.



Conducted orientation workshop for stakeholders:

To facilitate the implementation of the education project for the project team the stakeholders in Marib district must have knowledge about the organization and the project activities in brief.



Therefore, the workshop had been conducted by YDN for health and education offices, ExU, SMC, local authorities. The workshop aimed to focus in the objectives of project that is to provide education services in three sites for 400 school-aged children IDPs in formal education in the Marib district, Marib governorate. Also, the workshop aimed to provide a deeper understanding for all information about the and education project to stakeholders to facilitate work between offices, and the project team and relevant authorities and to provide support in implementing activities accurately and timely.



YDN conducted need assessment to enroll the school-aged children will be targeted in the IDPs sites in Marib district, Marib GoV:

Coordination was made with the Office of Education, SMC, and with the executive unit in Marib governorate about the process of registering students in the targeted IDP camps. the education needs were summarized in the three targeted IDPs sites in Marib district of Marib governorate by conducting need assessment and the assessment was conducted in coordination with ExU unite and education office. The needs assessment in the targeted IDPs sites (Al-Hawi, Al-Arqqeen, Safer) obtained information about the education situation in the IDPs sites and got the full numbers of the students in the camps to enroll all the students. Also, the assessment results showed all the information about the education services in the targeted IDPs sites, and determined the appropriate sites to established the temporary learning spaces.

Third cycle distribution of food baskets in four governorates Taiz, Marib, Abyan, and Shabwa:

YDN is continuing the implementation of food security that aim to increase access to food for families with severe food insecurity where the distribution take place in four Gov, 8 district, Taiz governorate (Al-Mudhaffar, Al-shamayteen, Al-Ma'afar, Sabr Al-mawadeem), two district in Marib governorate (Marib City, Marib Al Wadi) and two district in the governorate of Abyan (Ahwar, Lawder) and a district in Shabwa governorate (Al Talh)

As a consequence, YDN has completed the distribution for the third cycle from mid of May to the end of the month, as well as the food baskets have distributed to cover the needs of 15,607 HH.

Provision of emergency food basket assistant for one round in some districts of Abyan, Taiz, Shabwa, Aden governorates:

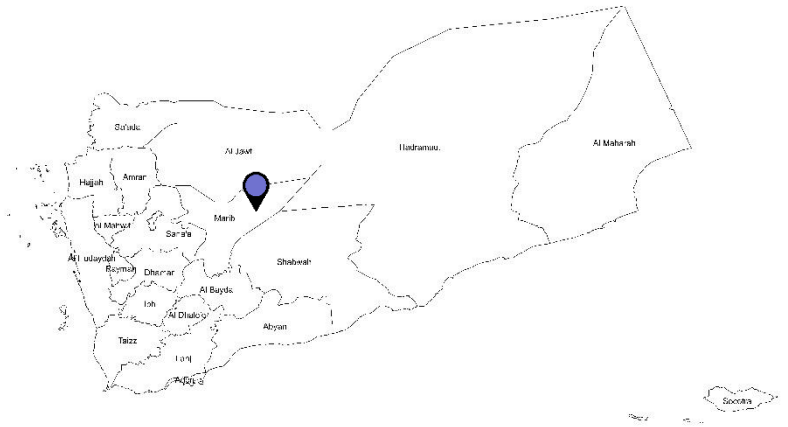
YDN plays a major role in responding to emergencies and ongoing displacement in all governorates, and have intervened to the call of FSAC cluster whenever there are any needs of relieving to the affected families from natural disasters such as flood and war in conflict areas. In April, YDN have distributed emergency food baskets for one round to the IDPs in

Aden Gov, where 350 baskets have distributed in Dar-Sa'ad district, 520 in Al-Mansoorah district, and 580 food baskets in Al-Sheikh Othman district. Moreover, distribution food baskets in Shabwa Gov, 400 in Ataq, 270 in Habban, 265 in Arma'a, 265 in Jordan districts. In May, the food baskets have distributed as following: Ahwar 1200, Lawder 600 in Abyan GOV, Al Shamyteen 1600, Saber Al-mawadeem 600, Al-Ma'afer 1495, Al-Modhffeer 1505, Thabab 133, Taiz Gov, Al-Talh 1000, Shabwa Gov.

Protection Program

Providing orphans with insurance cards and cash transfer support in Marib governorate:

Refqat al-Habib project team, which is being implemented in Marib Governorate, continues to provide health services by contracting with a hospital within the governorate and providing an insurance card with a 15% reduction in the value of medical services to 25 orphans who have lost their breadwinner, the head of the family, also monthly cash transfers were provided to the same target group at an amount of 30,000 per month. This project is funded by the Selah Foundation for Development
